


## READING AIDE



Focus Group: K-3rd grade

GOALS

**Describe** how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges.

- -What do you think this book is about?
- -What is a fact?
- -Why do you think the FACT is sad?

Pre-Reading

- -How are people treating the FACT?
- -Do you think the FACT should have lied?
- -What did The Authorities do the the FACTS?
- -How did the FACTS escape?

During Reading

- Why do you think the FACT was treated so badly?
- -Why do you think that some people chose to ignore the facts?
- -Should people tell a LIE just because someone doesn't like the facts?

**After Reading** 

- -Have your reader differentiate between a FACT and OPINION. You can chose simple things about themselves or about your home.
- -Talk about Truth. Discuss how people can avoid facts because they are uncomfortable. You can discuss what's happening now

with the pandemic. Make it age appropriate.

## GOALS

**Describe** how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges.

**Ask and answer** questions regarding how the READER would handle events

-Who is Shuri? Find out who she is and what she is known for in the Marvel Universe.

**Pre-Reading** 

Because this is an upper grade book, have your reader follow the <u>Weekly Reading Log</u>

**During Reading** 

How did Shuri use knowledge to save Wakanda? Is knowledge more powerful than fighting? Find (2) textual examples of either and write a 3 paragraph response in support of your answer.

After Reading

- Use the paired text (comic) to discuss similarities and differences in the character.
- -Have the reader discuss which character they liked the most and why
- -Have the reader provide an alternate ending for this book. \*\*Read this book with your kid. It's a great family read!
